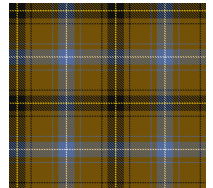

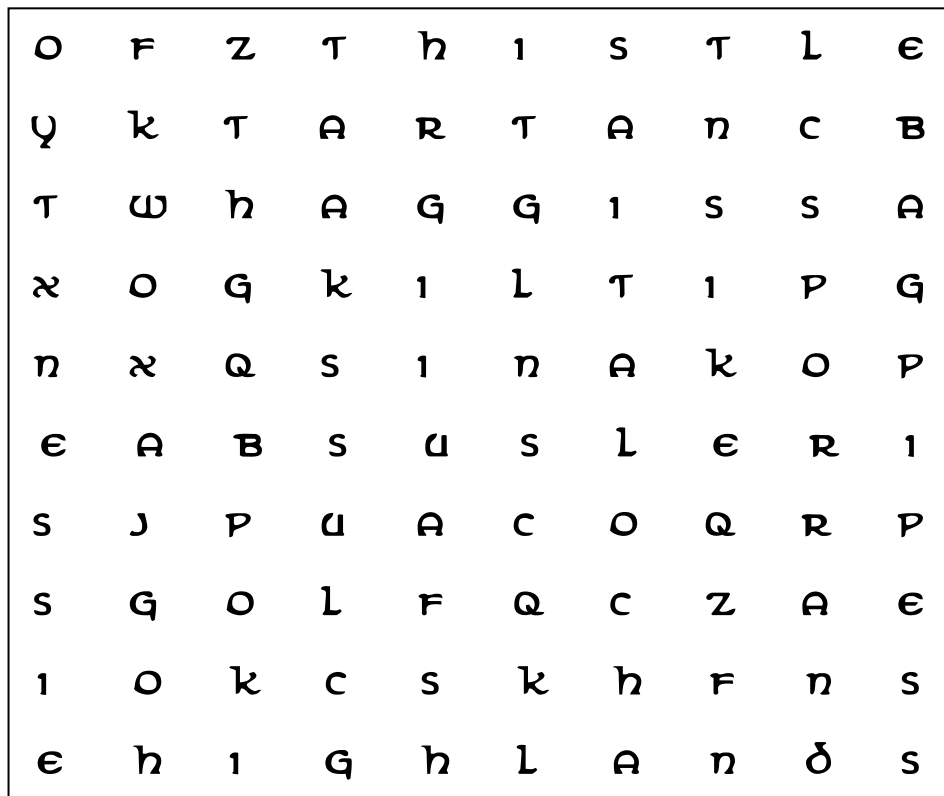

Who's Who in Scotland

MATCH THE NAME TO A FAMOUS PERSON IN SCOTLAND'S HISTORY

THIS WOMAN WAS THE QUEEN OF SCOTLAND FROM 1542-1567. SHE WAS FORCED TO GIVE UP HER THRONE AND MOVE TO ENGLAND. SHE WAS BEHEADED BY ORDER OF HER COUSIN, QUEEN ELIZABETH I.

THIS MAN WAS BORN IN DUNBAR, SCOTLAND AND MOVED TO THE USA IN 1849. HE BECAME AN IMPORTANT NATURALIST AND FOUNDED THE SIERRA CLUB. HIS WORK HELPED CREATE OUR YOSEMITE AND SEQUOIA NATIONAL PARKS.

THIS MAN WAS BORN IN SCOTLAND. WHEN HIS BROTHER BECAME DEAF, HE BECAME INTERESTED IN WORKING WITH SOUND. HE LIVED IN CANADA AND THE USA AND IS BEST KNOWN AS THE INVENTOR OF THE TELEPHONE.

THIS MAN WAS ONE OF THE GREATEST KINGS OF SCOTLAND. HE WAS A FIERCE FIGHTER FOR THE FREEDOM OF SCOTLAND FROM THE ENGLISH.

THIS BRAVE WOMAN RISKED HER OWN LIFE TO HIDE BONNIE PRINCE CHARLES AFTER THE DEFEAT OF THE SCOTTISH CLANS AT THE BATTLE OF CULLODEN IN 1746.

THIS MAN WAS ONE OF THE MAIN LEADERS OF SCOTLAND'S WAR OF INDEPENDENCE FROM ENGLAND. HE WAS CAPTURED AND EXECUTED BY THE ENGLISH BEFORE THE SCOTS WERE ABLE TO ACHIEVE INDEPENDENCE FROM ENGLAND.

THIS WOMAN WAS ONE OF SCOTLAND'S FIRST WOMAN DOCTORS. SHE OPENED A HOSPITAL FOR THE POOR WOMEN OF EDINBURGH AND SERVED AS A DOCTOR IN WW1.

THIS MAN IS KNOWN AS SCOTLAND'S GREATEST POET. HIS WORKS ARE THE STORIES OF ORDINARY SCOTSMEN AND WOMEN AND HIS POEMS AND SONGS HAVE BEEN LOVED BY MOST OF THE WORLD.

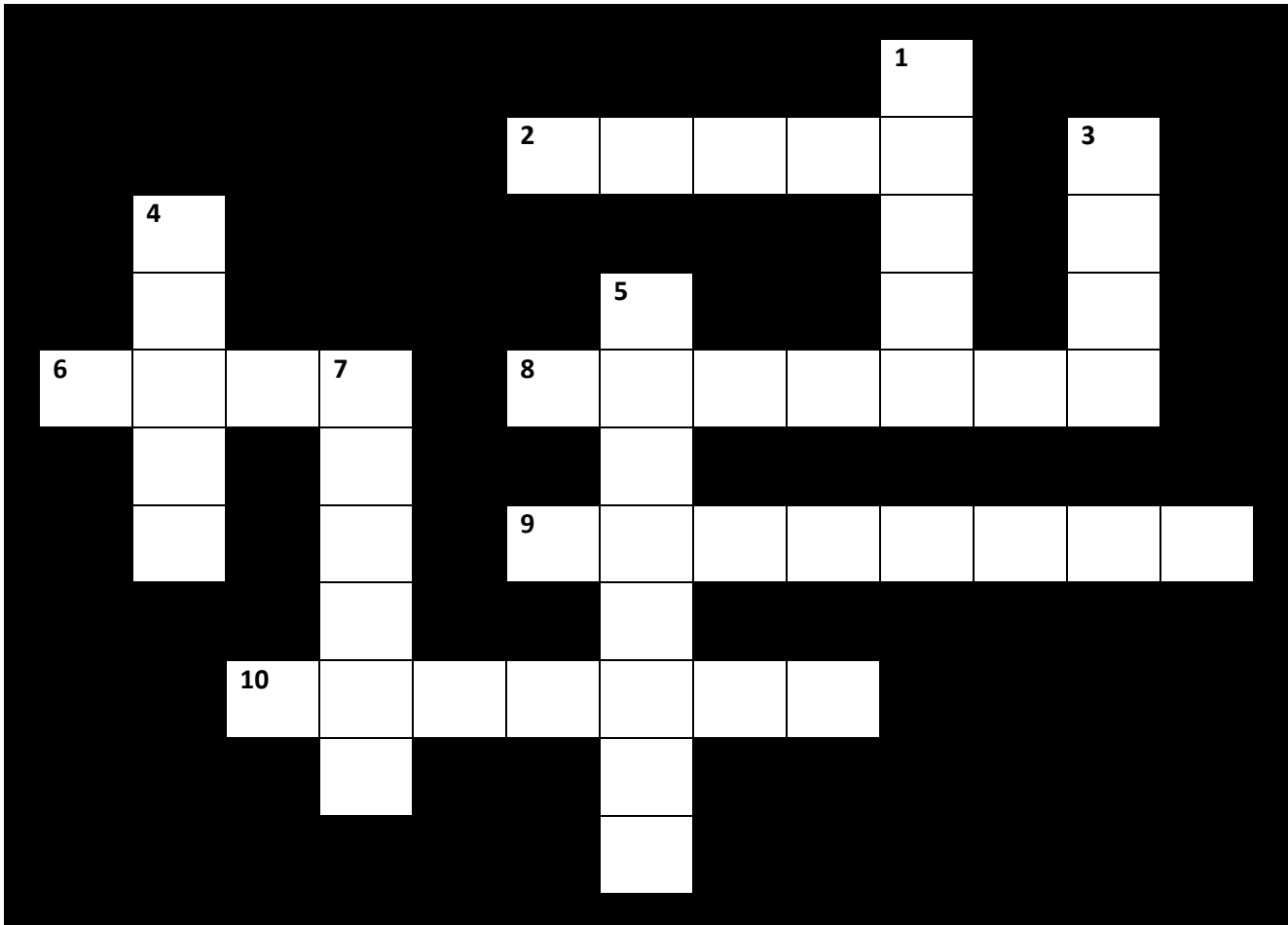

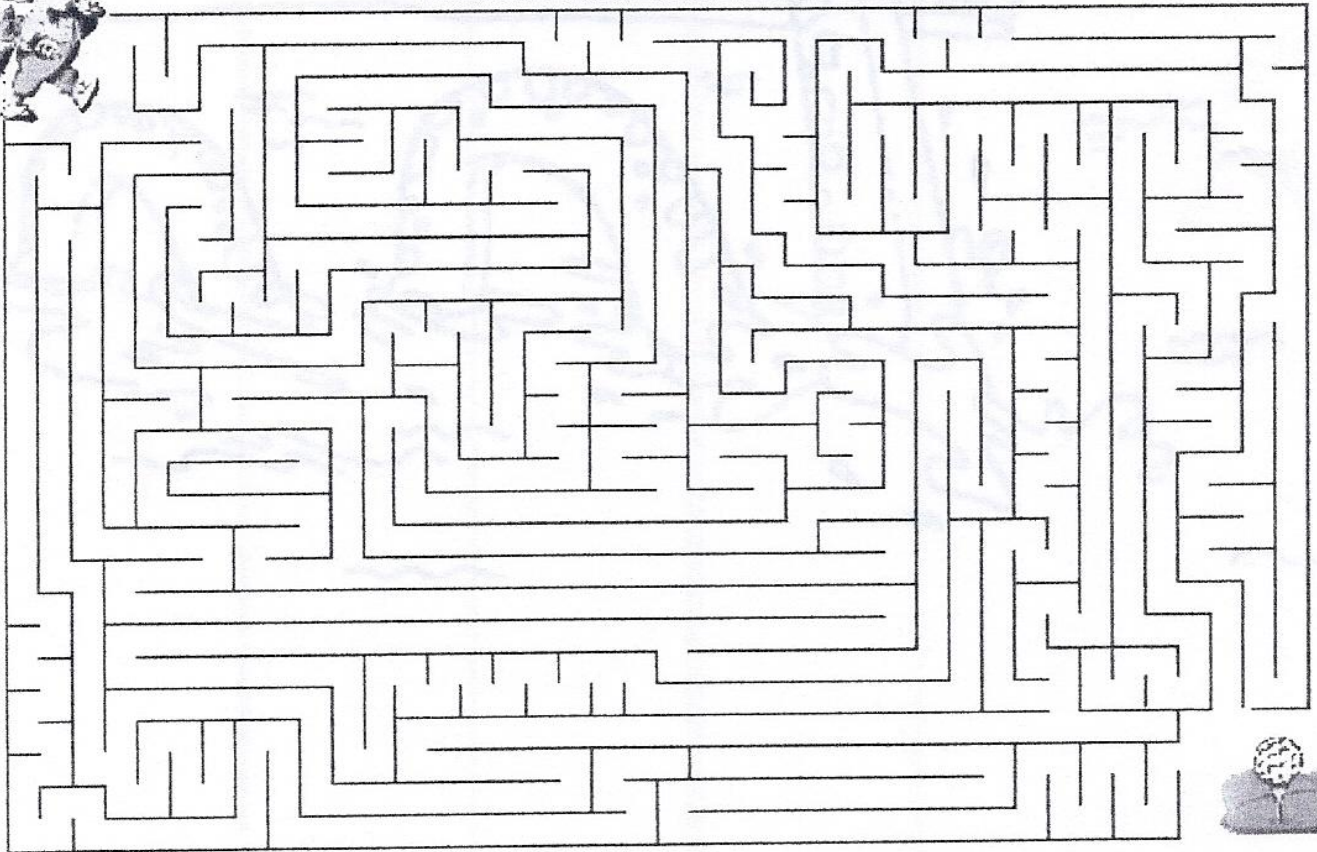

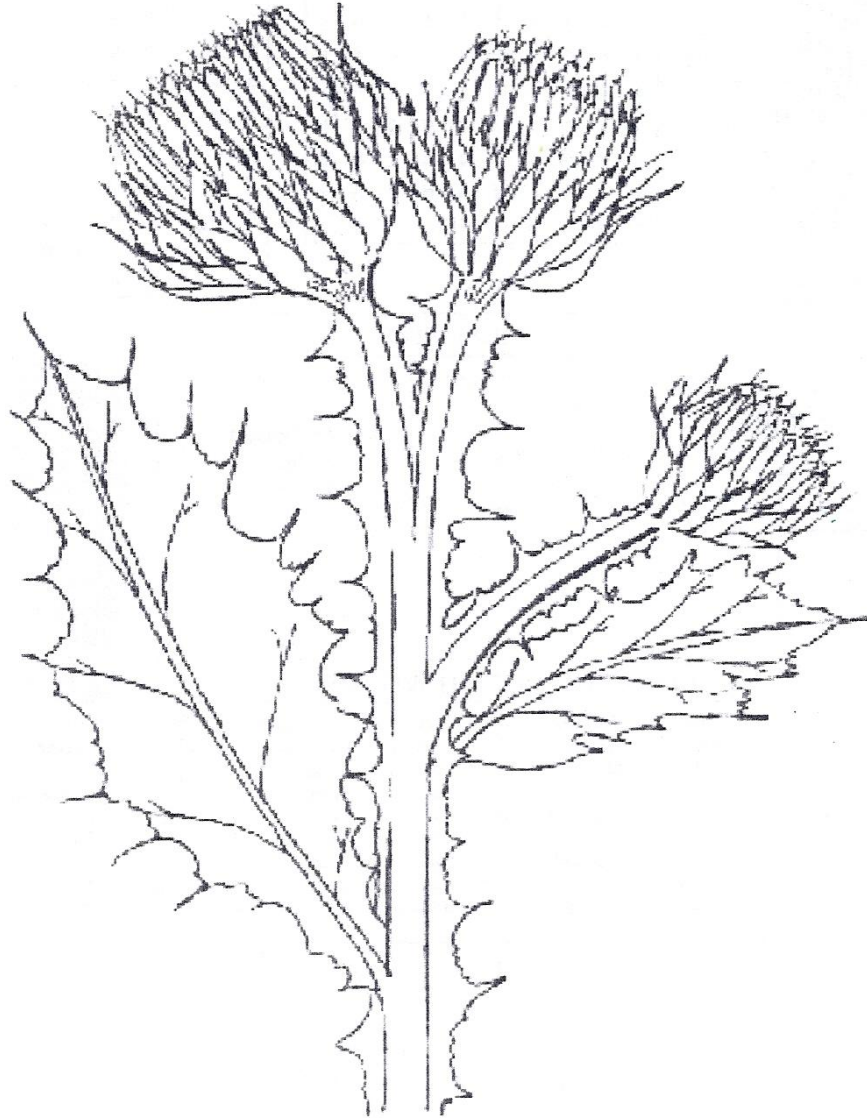
A GOLFER'S MAZE
